Teaching Points

1. Elementary Work, as per CARs 706.10;
2. Fuelling procedures:
 - a) types of fuel, oil and fluids used in the helicopter;
 - b) correct fuelling procedures;
 - c) procedures for checking fuel, oil and fluids and the proper securing of caps.
3. use of tow bars;
4. installation of protective covers on the helicopter;
5. procedures for operating in cold weather, such as:
 - a) moving the helicopter out of a warm hangar when precipitation is present;
 - b) the environmental impact of employing de-icing or anti-icing fluids (not authorized at Campbell Helicopters); and
 - c) engine and cabin pre-heating procedures, including proper use of related equipment.
6. Weight and balance procedures.
7. Technical dispatch procedures.

NOTE: This training is a addition to that provided by Campbell Helicopters' AMO in order to be certified to conduct Elementary Maintenance tasks and Daily Inspections.
